



# Hayling Island Horticultural Society



## 100 Plus Club

### Rules

1. The Club shall be called "The Hayling Island Horticultural Society 100 Plus Club"
2. The object of the club shall be to support the Hayling Island Horticultural Society by raising funds for its sole benefit.
3. The club shall be run and administered by the Hayling Island Horticultural Society Committee
4. Membership of the Club is only open to members of the Hayling Island Horticultural Society.
5. The 100 Plus Club year shall run from March to February.
6. A subscription of £12 per year is payable for each membership "unit". That sum shall be payable in advance by cheque, to be received by the 15<sup>th</sup> March each year.  
\*Anyone joining the Club after that date shall pay the sum of £1 for each month remaining in the year, to be received by the end of the month before membership commences i.e. if joining in May, £9 will be payable and will be included in the June draw, or August £7 will be payable to be included in the September draw
7. There shall be no limit to the number of "units" that any member may purchase.
8. A separate ticket will be issued for each unit purchased. It will bear the draw number and the full name and address of the holder. The ticket will act as a receipt and will also be proof of purchase.
9. 50% each "unit" sold will be allocated for prize money. There will be three prizes each month in the ratio 5:3:2 for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places respectively. (For example if 100 "units" are sold the prizes will be 1<sup>st</sup> £25, 2<sup>nd</sup> £15, 3<sup>rd</sup> £10). No "unit" is eligible for more than one prize in any one month.
10. All prize monies will be paid by cheque only to the winning "unit" holders.
11. The monthly draw will be carried out by persons having no financial interest in the Club. If for any unforeseen reason a draw is unable to take place, 2 draws will be made in the following month.
12. The results of the monthly draw will be published in the Society's periodic newsletters and on the Society's web site [www.hihs.org.uk](http://www.hihs.org.uk).
13. Full and proper accounts of all receipts and expenditure will be kept. They will be audited annually and report and financial statement for the Club will be presented at the Society's AGM, though any member may request the production of such a record for inspection at any reasonable time.
14. In the event of any dispute in connection with the rules or any other activity of the Club, the organising committee shall be the sole arbiters and their decision shall be final.
15. The payment of the annual subscription will be deemed to be unqualified acceptance of the rules and conditions.
