3 blooms to a vase. Double points - see Rules 39 and 41.
2. **Daffodils** - 6 cultivars, 1 bloom of each, 6 vases. Double points - see Rule 41.
3. **Daffodils Trumpet** - any cultivar, yellow, 3 blooms, 1 vase. (Division 1)
4. **Daffodil Trumpet** - any cultivar, yellow, 1 bloom. (Division 1)
5. **Daffodils Trumpet** - any cultivar, bi-colour or white, 3 blooms, 1 vase. (Division 1)
6. **Daffodil Trumpet** - any cultivar, bi-colour or white, 1 bloom. (Division 1)
7. **Daffodils Large Cupped** - any cultivar, 3 blooms, 1 vase. (Division 2)
8. **Daffodil Large Cupped** - any cultivar, 1 bloom. (Division 2)
9. **Daffodils Small Cupped** - any cultivar, 3 blooms, 1 vase. (Division 3)
10. **Daffodil Small Cupped** - any cultivar, 1 bloom. (Division 3)
11. **Daffodils Double** - any cultivar, 3 stems, 1 vase. (Division 4)
12. **Daffodils** - any cultivar, 3 stems, 1 vase. (Divisions 5 - 13)
13. **Daffodils** - 1 cultivar, any number of bulbs. 1 container, maximum diameter 305mm. See Rule 22. (Divisions 1 - 13)
14. **Daffodils** - mixed, 1 vase or container. Maximum stems 9. Arranged for effect.
15. **Hyacinths** - 1 cultivar, 1 pot or bowl. Maximum bulbs 6.
16. **Any Flowering Bulb(s) or Corm(s)**, other than hyacinth or daffodil - 1 cultivar, 1 pot or bowl, any number.
17. **Camellia Stems**, 3
18. **An Orchid in Bloom** - maximum pot diameter 400mm. See Rule 22.
19. **Hellebore Heads** - 5, in a palette (palette provided).
20. **Polyanthus** - any cultivar(s), 5 stems, 1 vase. See Rule 22.
21. **A Spring Flower** - any one cultivar, 5 stems, 1 vase. See Rule 22.
22. **Spring Flowers** - mixed, any number, 1 vase, arranged for effect. See Rule 22 - **NO SHRUBS**.
23. **Cactus/Succulent** - 1 pot/container, max diameter 230mm. See Rule 22.
24. **Flowering Shrub** - 1 cultivar, 3 sprays, 1 vase.
25. **House/Pot Plant** - no bulbs or corms. Maximum pot diameter 300mm. See Rule 22.

**27. Daffodils** - 3 cultivars, 1 bloom of each. 1 vase.

(Divisions 1-4)

**28. Daffodil Trumpet** - any cultivar, 1 bloom.

(Division 1)

**29. Daffodil Large Cupped** - any cultivar, 1 bloom.

(Division 2)

**30. Daffodil Small Cupped** - any cultivar, 1 bloom.

(Division 3 or 9)

**31. Daffodil** - any cultivar, 1 stem, except Divisions 1-3.

**32. Daffodils** - any cultivar(s), 3 stems, 1 vase. See Rule 22 - **NOVICE CLASS**.

**33. Daffodils** - any cultivar, any number of bulbs, 1 container, maximum diameter 300mm.

**34. A Posy of Flowers** - not exceeding 125mm in diameter.

**35. Hellebore heads** - 5 in a palette (palette provided).

**36. House/Pot Plant** - in bloom or fruiting. No bulbs, corms, cacti or succulents. Maximum pot diameter 300mm. See Rule 22.

**37. An Orchid in bloom** - maximum pot diameter 400mm. See Rule 22.

**38. Pansies or Violas** - any cultivars, 5 blooms in a palette (palette provided).

**39. Spring Flowers**, mixed - any number up to 6 varieties. 1 vase, arranged for effect. See Rule 22.

**NO SHRUBS.**

**40. Tulips** - any cultivar, 3 blooms, 1 vase.

**41. An Alpine Garden** - container not to exceed 300mm x 300mm. See Rule 22.

**42. Cactus Garden** - (succulents may be included), container not to exceed 410mm width, length or diameter. See rule 22.

**43. Cactus or Succulent** - 1 pot/container, maximum diameter 230mm. See Rule 22.

**44. Shrub stems** - flowering &/or foliage, arranged for effect, container not to exceed 230mm diameter. See Rule 22.

**45. A Flower and a Vegetable** - a cut flower and a vegetable.

**46. A Spring Container** - flowers, bulbs, growing (foliage optional) in a container, maximum diameter 300mm. See Rule 22.

**47. Leeks** - with roots and foliage, 2.

**48. Onions** - 2017 harvest, 3. see Rule 20.

**49. Radishes** - with roots and foliage, 5 on a plate.

**50. Rhubarb** - trimmed, sticks, 2.

**51. Any other vegetable** - see page 46.

**52. Trug or Basket of Garden Produce** - arranged for effect.

Maximum trug size 500mm x 300mm. Double points - see Rule 41

**SMELL AND VOTE** - Open

**53. Daffodil** - most fragrant bloom, any cultivar, 1 stem. One Prize only, judged by the votes of the visitors.
